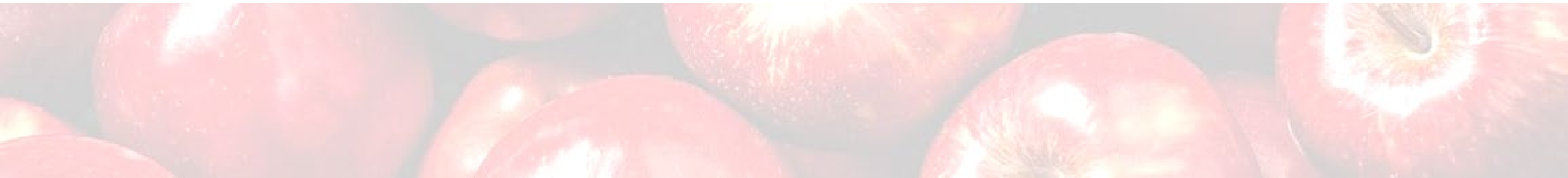
Autumn Glory

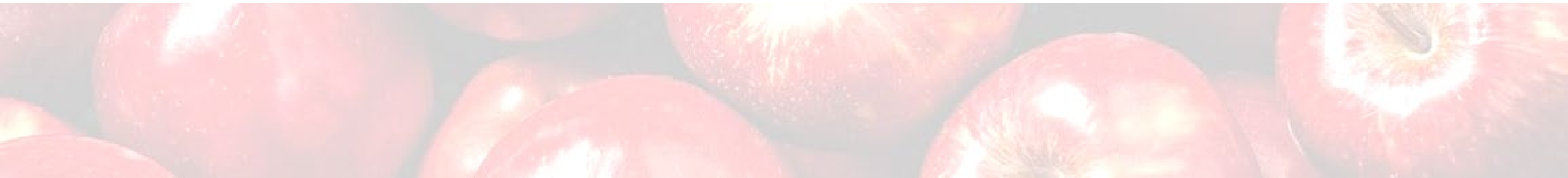
Cameo

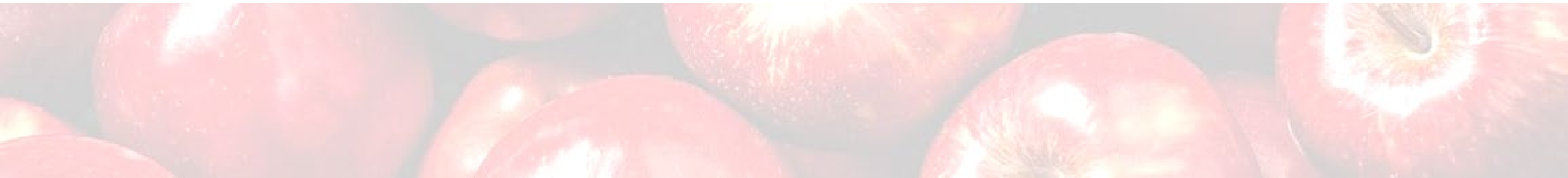
Cripps Pink

Envy

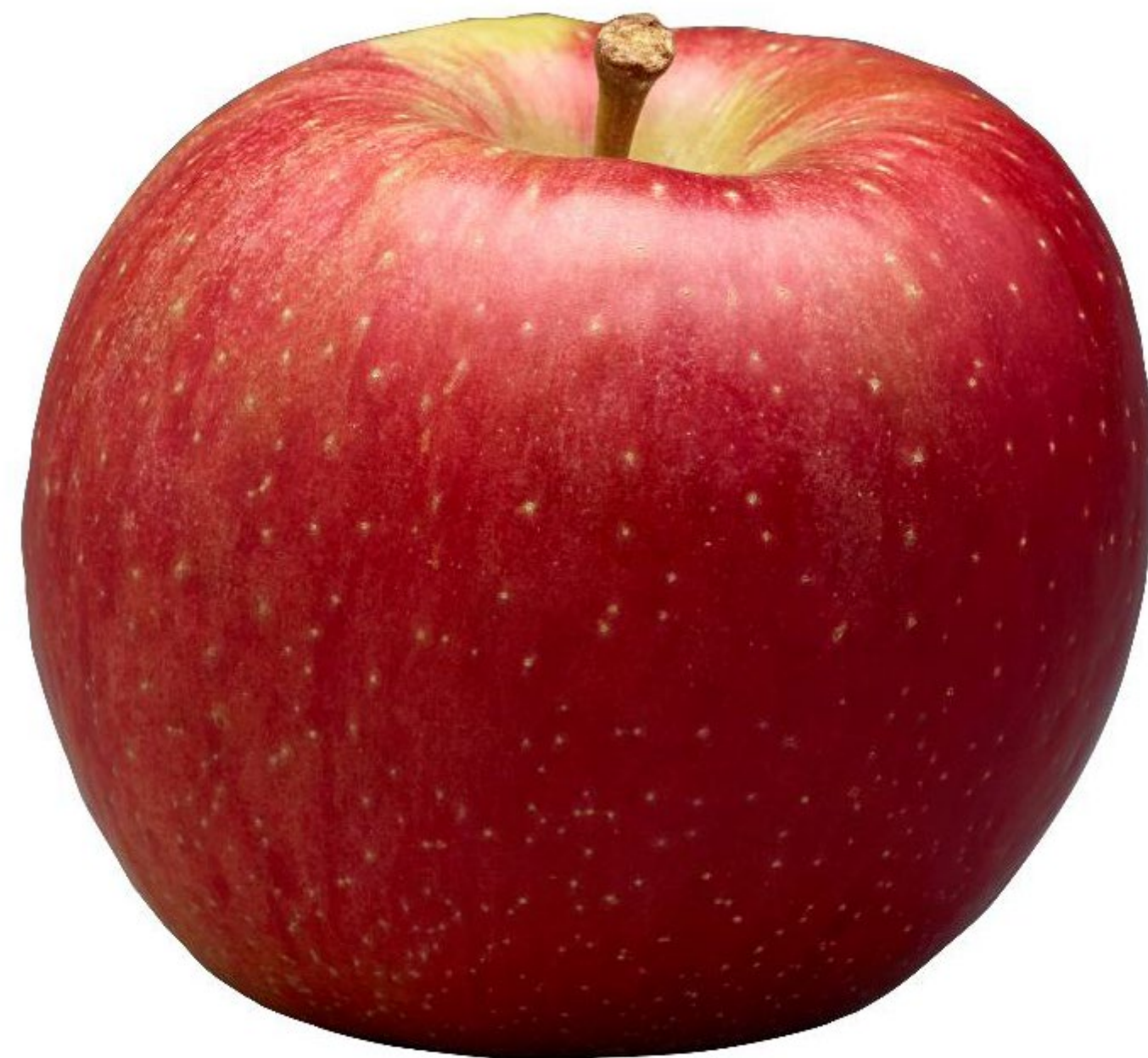
Description

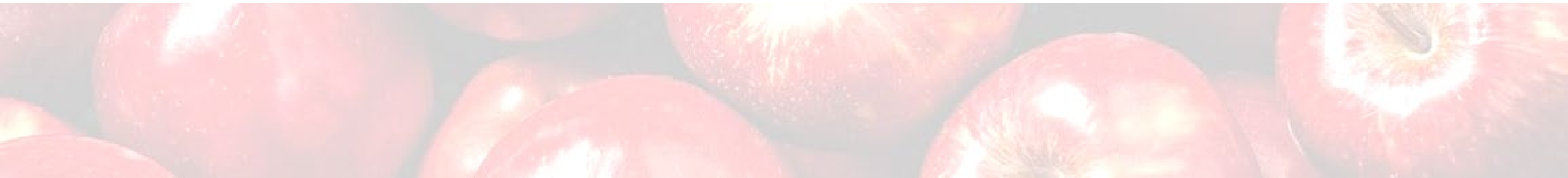
Juici

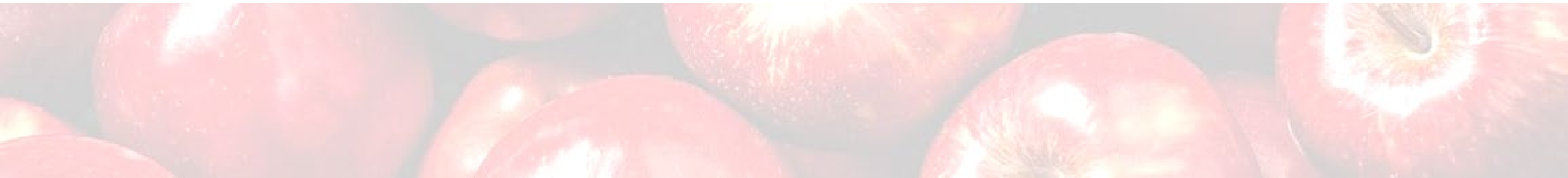
Kiku

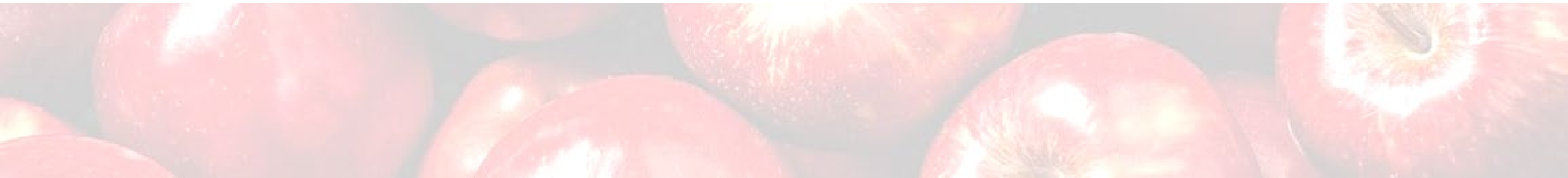
Koru Plumac

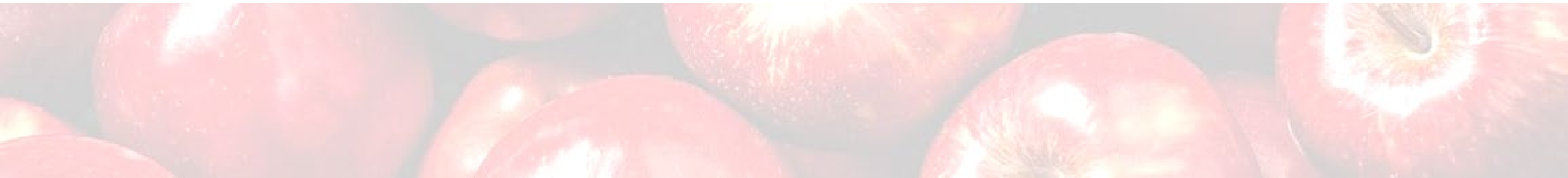
Lady

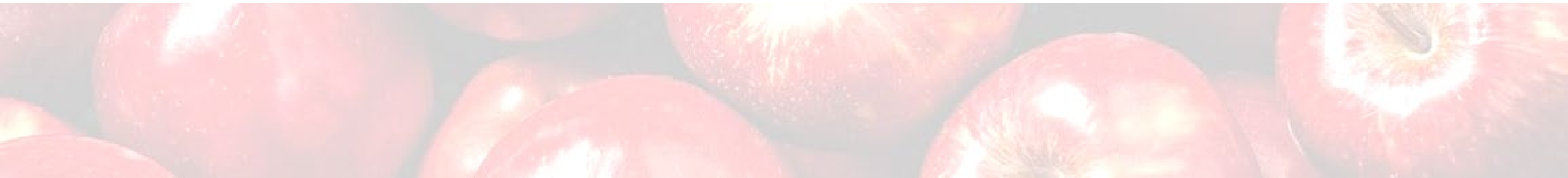
Lucy Glo

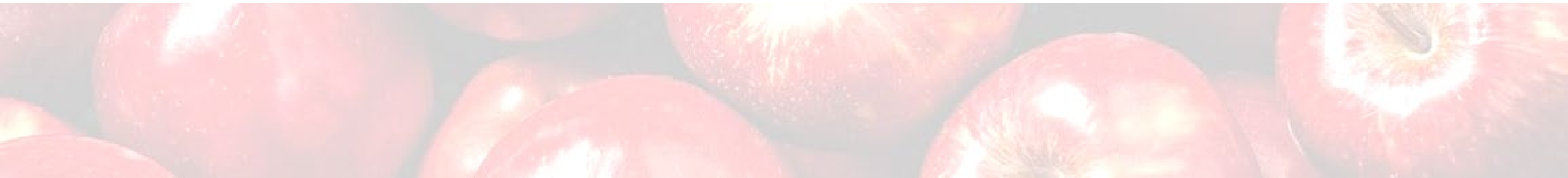
Lucy Rose

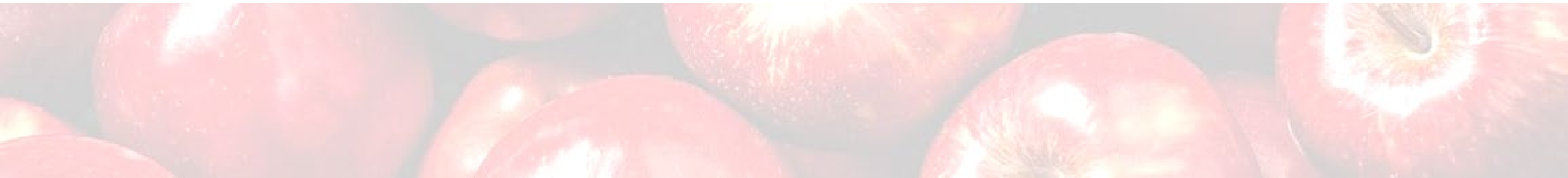
Pacific Rose

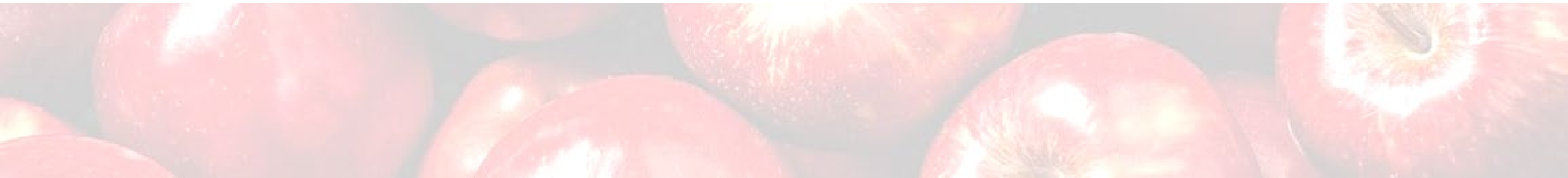
Rave

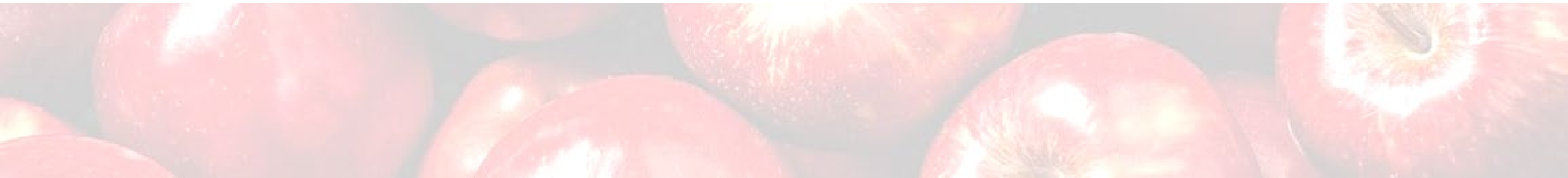
Sweet Tango

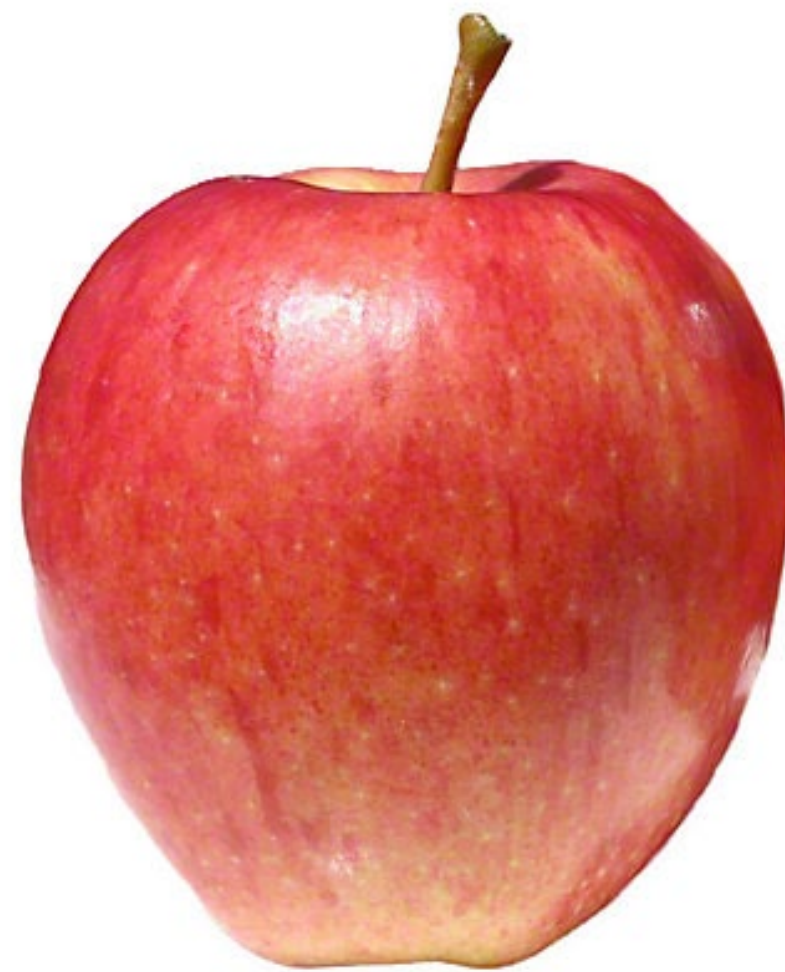
Description
